### **Experiment with British Library's Digital Collections and Data**



data.bl.uk is an 'experimental creative digital and physical space' to get access & support to use the British Library's digital collections & data to develop an idea.

British Library Labs / BL Labs, established in 2013, was the first national library in the world to set up a 'Laboratory or Lab' to support and inspire the experimental use of its data and digital collections in exciting and innovative ways, through competitions, awards, events and collaborative projects. The number of 'Labs' in Galleries, Libraries, Archives and Museums (GLAMs) or 'GLAM Labs' around the world has since grown and has developed into an international community.

'data.bl.uk', launched by BL Labs in 2015 is a 'digital / data research space' to enable researchers to easily download often large amounts of data and digital collections in order for them to conduct their own experiments manually and / or computationally. We want to encourage researchers to learn, make mistakes, play and have fun while they develop their project ideas. Where appropriate and time willing the BL Labs team will be happy to support



New collaborative **digitisation** project for **40+ items** from the BL Chinese collection of rare books and manuscripts covering topics such as history and literature





Maps showing locations of Business and IP Centre (BIPC) and Living Knowledge Network (LKN) partner libraries









St Pancras Transformed completed in London, with new BL galleries and learning centre, HQ for Turing Institute and major commercial science research centre


