Největší Čech (The Greatest Czech) is the Czech spin-off of the BBC Greatest Britons show; [1] a television poll of the populace to name the greatest Czech in history.[2] The series was broadcast by the national public-service broadcaster, Czech Television.[1] The presenter of the programme was Marek Eben,[3] who was also nominated to be in the Top 100; however, since he was presenting the show he was not eligible to be included in the final list.

The counting and ranking of the nomination votes took place during January 2005; the top 100 were announced on 5 May; and the final rankings were announced on 10 June 2005. The first round was won by the fictional genius Jára Cimrman, but he was disqualified. [4][5]

1. King Charles IV, Bohemian king (1346–1378) and Emperor (1355–1378), founder of Charles Bridge and Charles University - 68,713 votes



Jára Cimrman [edit]

The first round of official voting for Greatest Czech was won by the fictional character Jára Cimrman created by Czech humorists Jiří Šebánek, Zdeněk Svěrák (who himself took the 25th place) and Ladislav Smoljak (79th). The fact that he is not a real person disqualified him from taking the title, as the rules stated that "it is only possible to vote for someone who was either born on, lived on, or in any way acted on the soil of Bohemia, Moravia or Czech Silesia."[7]








National Library of the Czech Republic ("NL CR")

NL CR is a **library with universal library collections** and other highly specialized collections.

NL CR is responsible to **keep** the historical and the conservation **collections for future**.

NL CR guarantees an equal access to public library and information services as well as to the other services provided by the NL CR for all the users.





NL CR - history

1556 | Jesuits came to Bohemia and built a college upon the ruins of the Dominican monastery – Klementinum.

1726 – 1727 | The construction of Klementinum was completed.

1777 | The empress Maria Theresia establishes Imperial-Royal Public and University Library, open to the public.





NL CR - history

1807 | The duty of legal deposit copy is extended to cover all Czech printers.

1935 | The library is renamed to the National and University Library.

1995 | The mission of the NL CR was established in the present role.








1. 3. 2020 | first three cases of infection

First Lockdown | "Best in COVID"

09/2020 - ... | Czech Republic ranked among the worst affected countries in Europe in terms of the number of newly infected people per million inhabitants

2021 | 25. 11. 2021 a record number of more than 27 000 persons infected per day was revealed







Covid Pandemic: security arrangements

16. 3. 2020 - ... | first restrictions of the movement freedom of the people

03/2020 - ... | obligation to wear the face masks

03/2020 - ... | all sports, educational, cultural, religious and artistic events were prohibited

03/2020 - ... | selected shops and services were closed



Response of the libraries? National Digital Library in the COVID mode!

Government Resolution No. 238, 1. 3. 2021, on making the National Digital Library accessible for the purposes of education, science and research as a substitute for restrictions on library services due to the COVID 19.

Licence agreements for authors - Dilia and OOA-S

Accepted by the Association of Czech booksellers and publishers

Costs: **80 000 000 CZK = 3 240 000 EUR / 6 months of the free access**. Payment procedures realized in the cooperation with National Library of the Czech Republic and DILIA + OOA-S.




Usability of the digital content: November 2020 - June 2021





National Digital Library in the DNNT mode Why the publishers were afraid to allow this solution?


The free online distribution of the books published after 1989 is a **strong threat to the titles available in the book market with sale potential and paid electronic services** provided by the publishers.

Every new book, author, topic can have its own competitive title available on the market - professional literature, older textbooks, novels...

Remote and free online access to DNNT books can compete with the latest paid titles on the market. This process can reduce sales possibilities.







DNNT index


DNNT index contains a **list of monographs and periodicals published in the Czech Republic, which are available via the out-of-commerce** digital access mode.

The number of works included to the list with the DNNT status can decrease (free works and works that were published in a newer edition are removed or their removal has been requested by the rights holder) or increase (additional titles that were proposed by the libraries for inclusion are added to the list once every six months and have undergone half-yearly exposure as a proposal for inclusion).

The integration of a work to the DNNT index enables its digital copy to be available, if it was taken and if the rights holder did not request their exclusion or if the publisher did not use the option to limit access based on a memorandum with the NL CR.






Number of titles (volumes) available in NDL; numbers up to 05/2022










